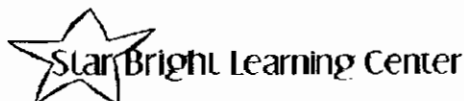

FOCUS ON MISSIONS

Gospel Tracts International

The mission of Gospel Tracts is to print and provide tracts to needed missionary points worldwide, usually at no cost to the missionaries in the field. Tracts are reprinted from those in existence or they are composed on subjects as needed by requests from the field. Several have been written by Dan McVey and native ministers in Africa. Over one million tracts were printed in 2008 with the biggest demand from points in Africa. We have supported this work for many years [19+]. Our present support is \$260 per month. Gospel tracts average expenses are about \$8,000 per month with over 35% of that going toward the postage cost of shipping tracts internationally. They have been especially hit hard with the rising postage and shipping costs. We need to continue to support and pray for this work.
