Emmanuel is 57 years old and is married to Comfort. They have three grown children. After serving many years as minister at the Abourso (Techiman) congregation in central Ghana, Emmanuel is now working with the smaller Takofiano church near his home. During the past year he has held campaigns in five towns nearby. Baptisms in all churches totaled 57 in 2008. Also, Emmanuel continues a radio ministry two days each week, resulting in a number of conversions in the Techiman area. He is currently studying with a Moslem school teacher who is influential in his community, and he has asked our prayers in this effort. He also has asked our prayers for his son, Arnold, who is tending to stray from the faith. Emmanuel has expressed a need for books, tracts, and assistance in buying a car. Please write Emmanuel and encourage him in his work for the Lord.

SPECIAL NOTE: The Moslem school teacher, mentioned above, was recently converted to Christianity by Emmanuel.
