George is 62 years old, is married to Juliana, and they have six children. George was a Pentecostal minister when he was converted to the church of Christ in 1985.

Western Hills has supported him since 1995. He started the Atebubu church in September 1996 and has been the minister there since. Atebubu has started churches in seven nearby towns, and the combined membership at the end of 2008 was about 312, up from 258 in 2007. Although, there were 72 baptisms in 2008. Atebubu continues to work on a permanent building, and Western Hills helped with their roof last year. George had a surgical operation in Kumasi to remove his prostate in Sept. 2008. During his recovery he stayed in the town of Toase, about 14 miles from Kumasi, whereas Atebubu is about 100 miles away. With George's help the church in Toase converted two and restored 12 while he was there. He is now fully recovered and is active again in Atebubu. (In addition to his regular support WHCOC sent \$500 to help with his medical expenses.) Please write to George and encourage him.
