Adjei-Mensa

Ghana, West Africa

Adjei-Mensah is 70, is married to Grace, and has eight children, two of whom are married. He was educated as an aeronautical engineer and served in the Ghana Air Force before his conversion in 1971. He left the Air Force in 1976 to preach full time, and then completed studies for a degree in Biblical Studies in 2001. He established the church at Pankrono in 1992, at which time Western Hills began his support. In 2008 Pankrono had an average attendance of 263; there were 29 baptisms. Their new church building is nearly complete with a basement + two floors; the roof was recently completed. (The Missions Committee sent money to help buy roofing materials). Illiteracy in the older population has hindered the development of elders, but special classes were underway in 2008 to prepare men to be deacons and elders by the end of the year; we have not received information as to whether they met that goal. Satellite churches have been started at the nearby towns of Wadie Adwumakasi and Dumanfoo. Please pray for Adjei-Mensah and write to encourage him.
