In order to allow James an extra year of full support, this decision was modified so the sun-setting process will not begin until Jan. 2011 and will be completed by the end of 2013. Hopefully during this extra year of full support, James will be able to replace the support he has lost. Michigan remains one of the most depressed area in our country and one of the most difficult to evangelize. James has written an excellent evangelism workbook, “Saving Souls in the 21st Century” that is available to purchase for \$12.
