During the months of September and October, the Siempre Familia team has continued activities to increase growth in the congregation such as youth group lock-ins, Men's Prayer Breakfast and others. Sunday services continue to have 100 in attendance and in the 50's at their Tues. night services. They have begun small group meetings and are putting together a youth group ministry. In November they had a class on Parenting and a good number turned out. On the 21st they had an early Thanksgiving Dinner with over 210 in attendance. As a result of this dinner, more than 70 visitation prospects were obtained. On Sunday the 22nd attendance was 118 with some visitors from the Thanksgiving dinner. There has been 15 baptisms since the end of March (8 months). Plans are to distribute over 200 baskets to people around the church for the holidays. Thank the Lord for the good things happening in our local mission work. Glory to God!
